Update | Goodwin House Infection Precaution Efforts

Below, please read a letter that we distributed via email to families and friends of Goodwin House Residents on June 15, 2021.

We are reaching out today with some exciting updates to our protocols!

You likely already learned that on Friday, June 11, we let residents know that Residential (Independent) Living residents who are fully vaccinated no longer need to wear masks in common areas on campus, both inside and outside. Today, we shared more updates with residents, and here are the highlights:

- Guests may now dine with residents in our main dining venues! Guests must be fully vaccinated. Children under the age of 12 may not dine in the dining venues. Reservations must be made in advance for all venues, including the Bistro.
- Our main dining venues are now open at 100% capacity.
- The beauty salons, pool and hot tub are open to all residents at full capacity.

For your visits to campus, we have these additional highlights and reminders:

- Visitors of residents in Independent Living, Assisted Living and Memory Support do not need to schedule visits. There is no limit on the number of visitors.
- We ask that visitors of residents in the Health Care Center continue to schedule visits at least 24 hours in advance [via our website](#). We also continue to limit 2 visitors per resident or resident couple.
- Children of all ages are welcome to visit campus (though children under the age of 12 may not dine in the dining venues as noted above). We ask that children aged 2+ wear masks during their visit. Visits to Health Care Center residents with children under the age of 12 will take place outdoors or in designated indoor spaces.
- Visitors may move throughout campus, but must wear masks, maintain social distance and practice frequent hand hygiene.
- Fully vaccinated visitors of residents in Independent Living, Assisted Living and Memory Support may remove their masks while in the resident's apartment.
