Update | Goodwin House Infection Precaution Efforts

Below, please read a letter that we distributed via email to families and friends of Goodwin House Residents on April 13, 2022.

Yesterday, the Infection Precaution and Planning (IPP) team met for its monthly review of our protocols and the latest information about COVID-19. While there are no changes to resident protocols to share with you at this time, we did send a letter to residents this morning that provides a few important reminders.

The IPP team did note that cases are rising again in our region, although they are not at the levels seen at the height of the surge earlier this year. With gatherings expected while families visit for spring break or for holiday celebrations for Easter, Passover and Ramadan, we encourage you to practice extra caution. If you have symptoms, please stay home and postpone your visit until your symptoms clear. If you dine with residents on campus, you must be fully vaccinated (a booster dose is not required, though it is encouraged).

We hope the next few weeks will provide opportunities to safely gather and celebrate together. Wishing you and your loved ones a healthy and happy spring!
