

Alice Story Biache Health Education Fellowship Award

Goodwin Living Foundation receives an annual grant from the Alice Story Biache Foundation for a Health Education Fellowship Award. This grant is awarded to qualifying Goodwin Living team members who are furthering their nursing education.

The award honors Alice Biache, the longtime Director of Professional Services for Goodwin Living who supervised all health care functions at GHA and GHBC. Among many things, Alice played an instrumental role in the development of Goodwin House Home Care and Goodwin Hospice.

Alice believed in caring for the whole person: body, mind, and spirit, and she was fully committed to continuing education for the health care professions. After more than 25 years of service and uplifting the lives of those around her, Alice retired.

Shortly thereafter, Alice Biache tragically died in an accident, leaving a legacy that would forever shape the lives of her loved ones and the future of Goodwin Living.

The Alice Story Biache Health Education Fellowship Award is administered by the Goodwin Living Foundation. The selection committee is chaired by the leadership at each community (Karen Doyle, Cathy Farmer and Joshua Bagley). They will select the recipients, in conjunction with the directors of each department and the chair of the Resident Health Committees.

Alice Story Biache Health Education Fellowship Award Application

Deadline: September 30, 2023

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must be full-time team members.
- Applicants must have worked a minimum of 2 years with Goodwin Living.
- Applicants must have an "Exceeds Expectation" rating on the most recent evaluation.
- Applicants must be enrolled in an accredited Registered Nurse degree program (A.D., B.S.N., M.S.N, N.P.). Note: You must have pre-requisites completed and be actively enrolled in RN training program.

Submit copies of the following from your university/program:

- Class schedule for the current semester
- Proof of enrollment into an accredited program

Award Amount and Terms: A two-semester scholarship of \$1,000 each semester is awarded to five Goodwin Living students for one academic year.

Prepare an essay between 400 - 500 words describing the following:

- Your passion for becoming a nurse (or continuing your education in nursing),
- Your future plans and goals
- In what ways do you embody Alice Biache's spirit of service to others and commitment to excellence.
