HIGHLIGHTS OF OUR YEAR, MADE POSSIBLE BY YOU!

736 donors

made gifts of \$500 or less, and those gifts totaled more than **\$109,320!**

255 team members

made gifts to the Foundation in gratitude for their colleagues, residents, patients, members and the place they call their second home!

882 tribute gifts

were received either in honor or in memory of someone who was special to the donor, with such gifts totaling over \$283,007!

100 team members

benefited from donations to our Staff Support Fund for the pursuit of further education.

More than \$202,089

in emergency grant support was provided to **100 team members** who were facing financial hardships.

Hospice end-of-life doulas and massage therapy

improved quality of life for **218** hospice patients and helped inspire an increase of giving from 99 Hospice Fund donors last year to **189** this year.

73 children and grandchildren of team members

received **\$1,000 grants** each to support their higher education, which was an increase from 47 grants the year before.

Now on the path to citizenship

this year alone, **56 people** received financial support for their citizenship application. Of that number, **40** were team members, and **16** were the immediate family members of our team members.

Since welcoming our first resident in 1967

Goodwin Living has never asked someone to leave because they exhausted their financial resources through no fault of their own.



WHAT DOES THE ANNUAL FUND SUPPORT?

Residents - Resident Support Fund

Donors allocate their gifts to this fund when they are passionate about helping those who run out of financial resources through no fault of their own. Many residents and family members find peace of mind knowing that when they move to Goodwin House Alexandria, Goodwin House Bailey's Crossroads or The View Alexandria, they will never have to move again, even if they outlive their financial resources. We are so grateful to have this gift of home provided by the many donors over the years who have supported the Foundation for this purpose.



In fundraising year 2023, a total of 17 residents received Resident Support with grants totaling over \$716,719.

Team Members - Staff Support Fund

Staff Support - Citizenship Application Fees

Goodwin Living team members come from more than 65 different countries, and many do not yet hold U.S. citizenship. The current cost to apply is \$725 for an adult and \$1,170 for a child, which can be a significant deterrent. Started in 2018 from a resident's idea, our Citizenship Application Fee program has already supported more than 176 team members by providing them with a grant that covers the full cost to apply.

- In fundraising year 2023, \$43,310 was provided for our unique Citizenship Application Fee Program. 40 Goodwin Living team members received citizenship application fee grants, and with the increased funding we were also able to offer citizenship grants to 16 spouses and children of staff. We are so grateful for the many resident volunteers who help to tutor our team members. With gifts to this fund, we also provide training materials for our resident tutors and study guides for our team members.
- In fundraising year 2023, we expanded our citizenship program to include the cost of applying for green card and work permit renewal for team members.

"As a social worker, I work confidentially with our residents and their family members if they begin to sense they are running out of resources and are afraid they will no longer be able to pay their monthly fees. I always feel so grateful to be able to share that there are funds available to help residents. Financial insecurity can be frightening and a major source of anxiety for not only our residents, but their loved ones as well. The domino effect that can happen when families have parents with financial struggles is significant, and I am so happy there are donors who help to make the Resident Support Fund possible! I have the pleasure of allaying everyone's fears by sharing that the monthly fees can be covered by gifts made to the Foundation. During our New Employee Orientation, I always tell the staff joining Goodwin Living about our Resident Support program. It is with a sense of pride that I tell new team members that Goodwin Living supports residents in a variety of ways throughout their life, even financially if it is needed."







Staff Support - Emergency Assistance

Inherent in the Goodwin Living mission is supporting team members in their daily lives. The reality is that many of our team members faced financial difficulties this past year. Yet they continued to bring the same joy and commitment to caring for residents, members, patients, clients and one another every single day.

In fundraising year 2023, the Foundation provided confidential emergency assistance grants to team members in need. This program provided funds for those who faced significant challenges such as overdue medical bills, car repairs for essential transportation and eviction because of overdue rent. In many cases, one overdue bill can cause a chain of negative events for someone living paycheck to paycheck in our high cost of living area. Our ability to rally around those in need as quickly as we can is what makes our community special.

• 100 team members received emergency assistance grants totaling just over \$202,089.

Staff Support - Tuition Assistance

This past year, we continued offering significant tuition assistance for those team members who seek to advance their studies and vocational training. After six months of employment, team members could receive up to \$2,625 in tuition support, and after two years, a person could receive as much as \$5,250.

- In fundraising year 2023, 100 Goodwin
 Living team members received tuition
 assistance totaling \$262,665, with additional
 funds for student loan repayments through a
 competitive application process.
- We provided 73 grants of \$1,000 each to children and grandchildren of team members who are pursuing higher education, through an application process.

Anonymous Member of the Emergency Grants Committee

"Serving on the Emergency Grants Committee has been an honor. Every week, this small and anonymous group of team members carefully and thoughtfully reviews applications from fellow team members who are experiencing a significant financial hardship or catastrophic event. Over the last several months alone, the committee has approved grants to support team members who have been in need of emergency housing; who have overdue utility or medical bills; who have faced eviction; and who have needed emergency car repairs in order to be able to safely get to and from work. Additionally, the committee assists these team members by providing resources to receive financial counseling and budget-setting guidance for future planning. I'm so proud to work for an organization that has an initiative like this that seeks to take care of its staff who are in need. These grants make a big difference in the lives of those around us, and I'm grateful that I can be a part of this program."

Area of Greatest Need - Unrestricted

These unrestricted funds allow the greatest amount of flexibility to the Foundation so that we can apply these funds where they are needed the most. This past year, we utilized funds from this area to support residents and team members in some of the ways listed above, as well as to enhance various programs such as providing horticultural therapy in partnership with Eldergrow; partnering with other organizations to provide animal and equine therapy; offering music programs such as Encore Music, Melody Makers, and the Sentimental Journey Singers; and funding unique equipment for those who need assistance, such as the "WhisperGLIDE" wheelchair swings. New this year was also a pilot program with Encore Learning for stimulating classes and clubs.

WHAT DO RESTRICTED FUNDS SUPPORT?

We also received other funds that were restricted for use and allowed us to support various areas of our mission.

Hospice Fund donations helped us provide even stronger hospice care for our residents and for the many patients we served beyond our campuses and across Northern Virginia. Over \$122,840 was raised in fundraising year 2023 to provide our hospice patients with the compassionate care and comfort they deserved at such a vulnerable time in their lives. We were able to offer truly individualized care and relief to our patients and their families with special services such as massage therapy and end-of-life doula care.

With gifts directed specifically to our Hospice Fund, we can enhance the quality of care we provide to hospice patients and their families.

StrongerMemory is a breakthrough program that helps improve brain health. Intended for everyone, whether you have a diagnosis of mild cognitive impairment or you simply strive to thrive as you age, StrongerMemory is designed to stimulate the brain's prefrontal cortex, which is the part of the brain that helps retrieve memories. Participants enjoy these benefits by spending just 30 minutes a day engaged in simple reading, writing and math activities. Thanks to a significant grant, we make the StrongerMemory materials widely available and accessible well beyond our campuses. As of December 2023, the program was being used in 21 states throughout the country, with an estimated 20,000 individual participants and 178 organizations.

"After more than 10 years living under the care of Goodwin House [Bailey's Crossroads], I decided it was time to make a significant donation. It was also time to retire from driving, so I contributed my car to the Goodwin Living Foundation – the car that had transported me since my arrival in 2010. The transfer was simple, and I was delighted to learn that its sale brought almost double the price I would have obtained by managing it myself, also resulting in a sizable tax deduction."

The Anderson Fund allowed us to reach new heights this year. We offered five high school seniors a \$500 college scholarship, we provided 10 team members student loan repayment grants of \$1,000 each, and we offered stipends for 11 college students to participate in our summer internship program. All these efforts helped us promote our wonderful organization, and with the hope of inspiring many to consider service in the senior living and healthcare field, it allowed us to introduce Goodwin Living to many individuals who are thinking about their careers!

The Goodwin Living People Engagement Manager asked interns to describe their internship experience in three words. Here are some responses that they texted back:

Today I saw she had a piece of paper with writing on it already. I was able to read the writing, and suddenly I turned and asked Mrs. A, "Did you write this by yourself?" She smiled and answered me proudly, "Yes, I did!"

Carolyn and I are driven by our personal journeys and experiences with family, friends and neighbors. As caregivers for our own parents at the end of life, we worked hand in hand with a wonderful team of hospice professionals, who were always there in time of need, with kindness and generosity. The team's technical and timely expertise in administering pain relief, with a gentle touch and even love for the family and patient, assisted in soothing and alleviating intense suffering for all concerned.

There was always an abiding sense of caring, plus a superior sense of anticipation by the Hospice Team for what may come next in their mission of support and guidance that was consistently, expertly and gently delivered. The tranquility provided by the hospice professionals kept chaos at bay and generated a surrounding sense of well-being. This provided for a peaceful and comfortable passing for those we truly love and cherish.

STRATEGIC INITIATIVES

The Goodwin Living mission and the strategic plan guide the direction of all the Foundation's fundraising programs. This plan, approved by the Goodwin Living Board of Trustees, is the roadmap to fulfilling our organization's vision. In the past several years, the Foundation has been grateful for some significant bequests that have allowed us to begin work on several of the strategic initiatives outlined in the plan. They have helped the Foundation establish an Internship Fund, a Brain Health Fund and a Technology Fund, as well as a Workforce Development Fund that is helping us find solutions for our ongoing workforce challenges.

Additionally, these bequests enabled us to fund six important team member positions: three in the Brain Health department, two music therapists and our People Engagement Manager, who manages our internship program and works closely with team members to ensure they know of and receive the support and resources available to them.



A PERSONAL STORY | OLIVIA BRICKEY



During her time at GHA, Olivia Brickey enjoyed walking her dog, Baby, in the GHA community garden.

Olivia Ann Collins Brickey grew up in Texas during the Dust Bowl and the Great Depression of the 1930s. She learned about persevering during hard times and saving money for the future from her mother.

Olivia made a life with her husband in the Capitol Hill neighborhood of Washington, D.C. for over 50 years. She enjoyed living within walking distance of the Library of Congress where she worked for over 35 years. Olivia was also active at Christ Episcopal Church on Capitol Hill. While volunteering with her church, she learned about Goodwin House Alexandria when taking communion to residents there one day. She didn't know at the time that Goodwin Living would later become an important part of her life.

After Olivia's husband died in 2006, her mother moved in with her, and they lived together until her mother died in 2010 at the age of 103. Five years later, Olivia joined Goodwin Living At Home with the notion that since she had no family, Goodwin Living At Home could be there for her when she needed it. A few years later, Olivia decided to move into Goodwin House Alexandria. She and her miniature poodle, Baby, were welcomed with open arms. Olivia commented regularly about the community that had become her family in such a short time. She shared about a time when she was sick, a group of residents took turns taking Baby on walks so that she could focus on healing.

During the pandemic, Olivia wanted to support all the team members who were going through difficult times. She said she remembered what it was like to not have much and to be scared, and she wanted to help where she could.

Over time, Olivia made many contributions to the Foundation and ultimately gifted her beloved house in Washington, D.C. to the Foundation in addition to leaving a portion of her estate. She said she wanted to support the Foundation because she knew she could make an impact on a place that had been so meaningful to her, and to influence the lives of people who worked to serve older adults. She gave in gratitude for the Goodwin Living team members and her fellow residents.

"I love being able to witness the impact of music therapy every day! This past year, I've had the pleasure of working with a resident, Howard Smith, who began singing at an early age and was a natural performer and musician. Performing was something he adored and was a big part of his life. He and his wife moved to Goodwin Living in 2010, and he jumped into every performance and singing group he could find – the Chorale, Spring Fling productions, etc.! However, since transitioning to Assisted Living with his wife, he had not been engaging in many music programs. This transition from Independent Living to Assisted Living can be difficult for residents, as many feel they lose part of their independence and engagement to the larger community.

When I met Mr. Smith, I began to learn how integral music was to his life. After we spent a few weeks singing and getting to know one another, he came up with the idea of giving a concert for the residents in the Assisted Living area. One week, I walked in the room, and he said, "I think I'm ready to perform again!" Over the course of a few months, we met weekly to select music, rehearse songs and work on the performance. His wife also sang along with us and loved seeing her husband perform again. During our sessions, he seemed to become more engaged and energized, and you could see the joy that singing brought to him. Our work together allowed him to feel more independent, and he was able to engage again with the Assisted Living community.

After months of practice, we held our duet concert to the delight of many fans. The concert featured a variety of music and discussion and was a highlight for all those who attended, including me! I thank all the donors who make music therapy possible at Goodwin Living. It is such a joy to see the power of music in the lives of the residents we see every day."
