For Team Members:

English as a Second Language classes are now eligible under the Tuition Assistance Program for team members who have been employed for at least six months. Resident tutors are also available for conversational English groups for additional practice.

For Family Members:

After a team member has been with Goodwin Living for at least one year of service, their immediate family members are now eligible for green card renewal and work permit renewal grants in addition to citizenship and DACA renewal. Immediate family is defined as mother, father, sister, brother, spouse, domestic partner, children (including stepchildren), grandchild, grandparent, mother-in-law, father-in-law, individual who took the place of parents during childhood, or others on a case-by-case basis and with prior approval.
